Walking Through Grief

Although, at time of writing, we are still “Talking through Grief” and our usual Zoom link. This gathering is for anyone who is grieving the loss of another individual - be it a recent or more distant loss. That pretty much includes anyone! So you, too, are welcome. We chat, we hear a reading about grief, often reflect on it, and then chat a bit more. Join us on Zoom (for now at least) on Wednesdays at 10:00AM.

Reflections & Connections

Every Wednesday evening at 7:30 people of the congregation gather on Zoom for what has become known as Reflections & Connections. Folk chat about anything at all, and then there is a more focused time with a reading, usually from scripture, and then either there are some thoughts shared by the leader, or there are one or two questions around which discussion revolves. Prayer follows, and then more general conversation. Sometimes the structure changes a bit. It is a wonderful way to stay connected in this time when we cannot gather physically; it is also a time to remember that our faith is relevant to our time.

Choir Fellowship
